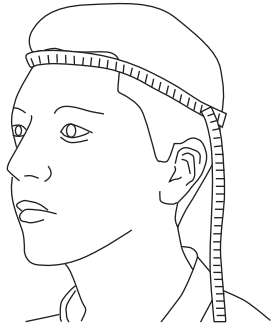


# ROSIE DEACON TRAIN CONDUCTOR HAT

## MATERIALS NEEDED

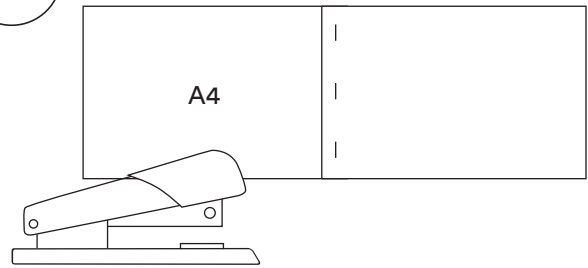
- Paper templates (hat brim and crown, decorations and hat strap)
- 2 x A4 paper (or use the hat crown template provided)
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Glue stick
- Colour pencils to decorate

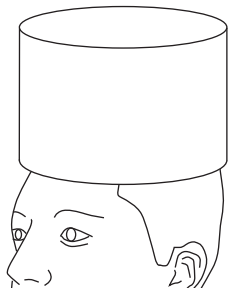
Measure the circumference of your head. Tip: you can use string if you don't have a tape measure.

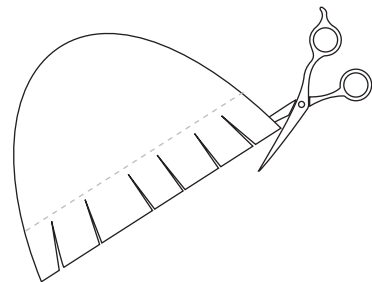
Staple the ends of two A4 pieces of paper together to make the hat crown or print the template provided.

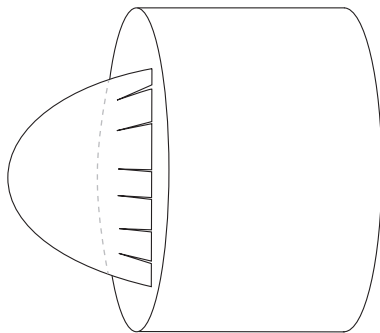
Fit the crown around your head then staple the other end together.

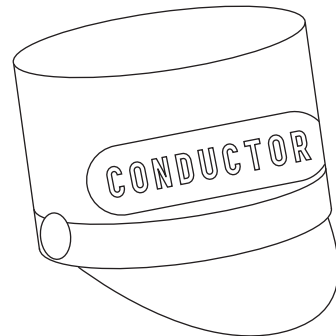
Print out the hat brim template and cut around the outline. The dotted line is the fold mark.

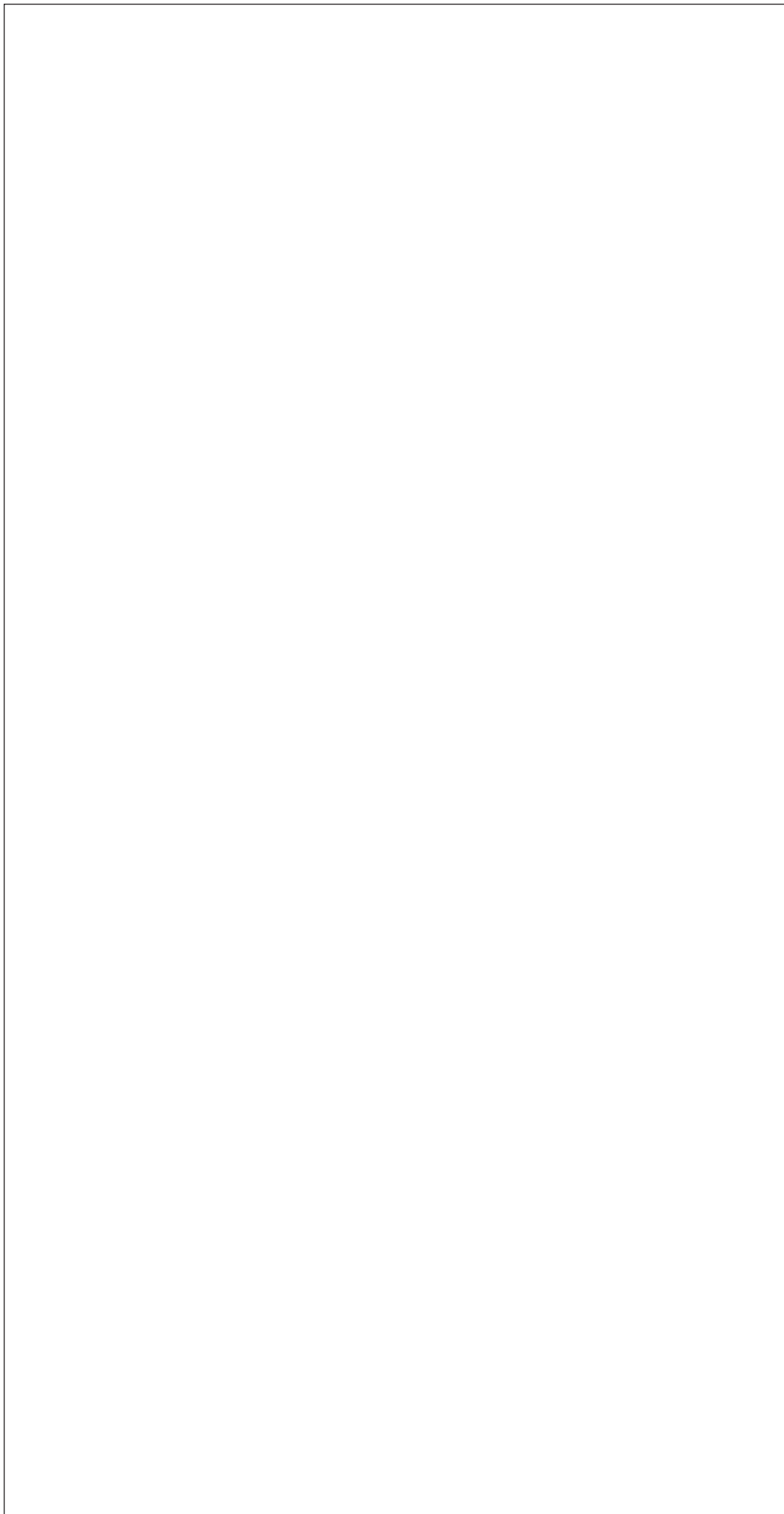
Glue the flaps to the inside of the hat crown

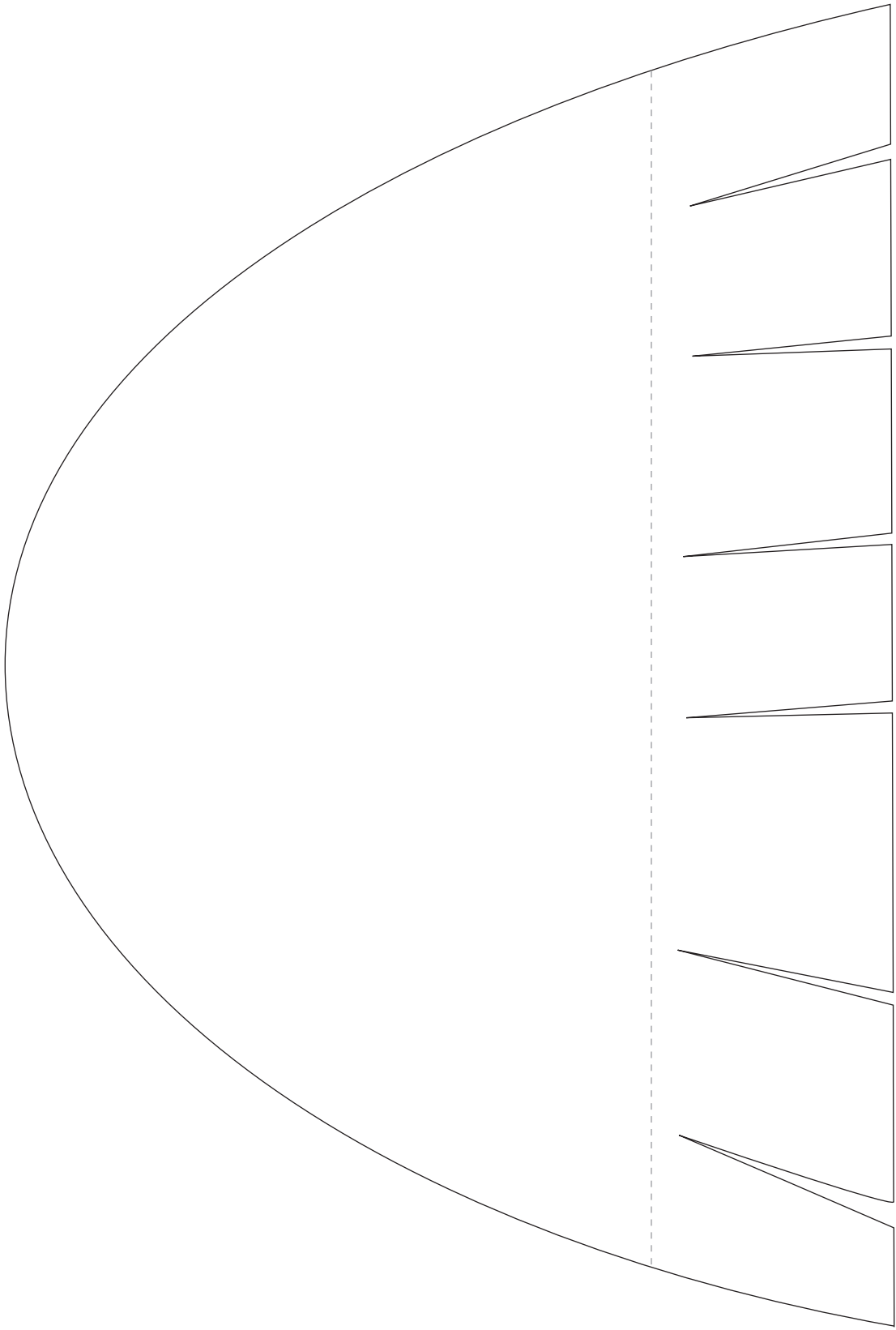


Print out the decorations template. Colour them in. Cut out the decorations and glue on the front of the hat.

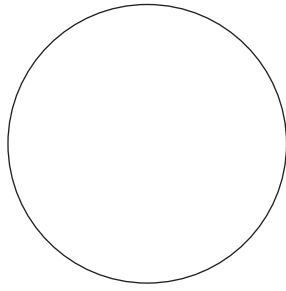
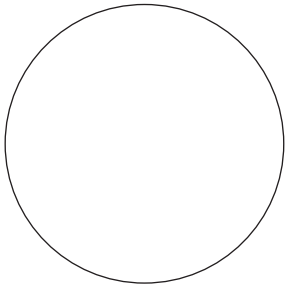

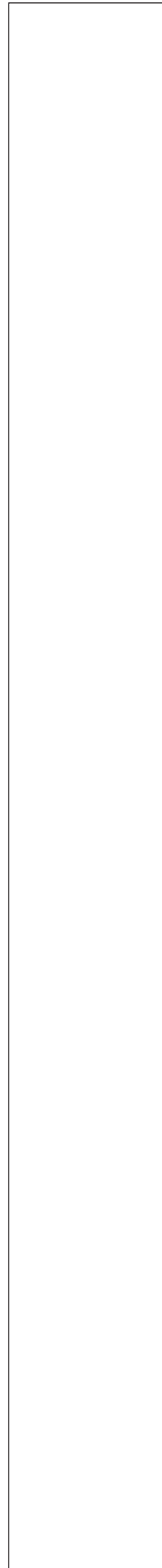
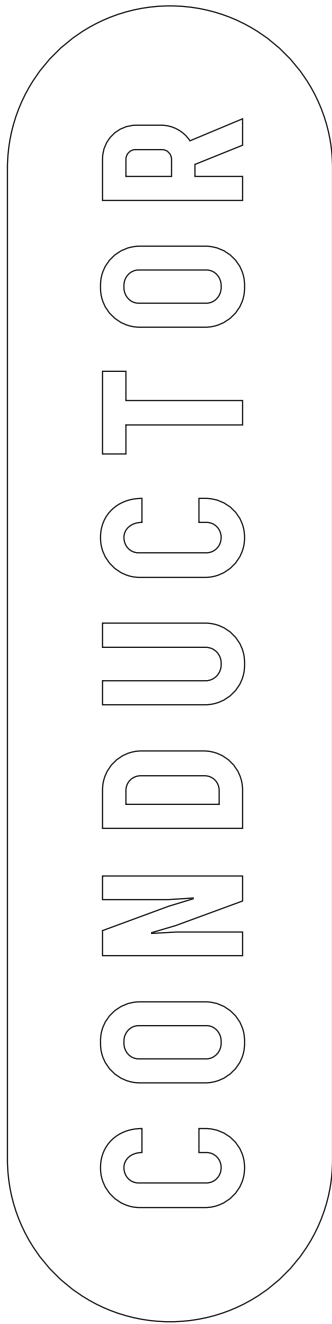
← Hat crown:
